How it works

This card opens the collection. It supports the learning of Al-Fātihah, the opening of the Qur'an, recited in every prayer — and introduces the student to how a recitation card works.

Each verse corresponds to one box — the seventh, longer, has two. A last box validates the whole surah:

- ♦ verse correctly recited — the mentor or teacher writes the date in the box;
- ♦ verse not yet learnt — the box stays blank, it is taken up again next session;
- ♦ once the seven verses are learnt, the student recites the surah in one go and the last box is validated.

The transliteration is a support for the non-Arabic-speaking student: it fades away as reading comes.

Each line runs across both halves of the card, from right to left; then move down to the next line.
