THE PATH

How it works

This card is issued to each student and corresponds to one objective to reach. The student keeps it at all times and presents it to their mentor or teacher at every recitation.

The objective is divided into weekly objectives. Each weekly objective corresponds to one box:

- ♦ objective met — the mentor or teacher validates the recitation by writing the date in the box;
- ♦ objective not met — the box stays blank, a new deadline for recitation is agreed with the student;
- ♦ at the end of each surah, a full recitation is done before moving on to the next.

The end-of-line boxes allow intermediate validations, to consolidate what has been learnt.

Each line is read from right to left, across both pages; then move down to the next line.
